2017 South Dakota State Indoor 3 Position Light Rifle Championship

Saturday April 1st, 2017



Match Date: Saturday April 1st, 2017. Registration starts at 9:am until 2 relays (20 Shooters) are filled. Relay #1 starts at 10:00 am (or sooner if all 10 positions are filled)
Relay#2 starts at 11:30 am (or 15 minutes after Relay #1 is finished)

Location: Garretson Sportsmen's Club Indoor Range, 48060 255th St, Garretson, SD
2 miles south of Garretson, S.D. on County Road 105
On I-90 Take Exit 410 North and go 5 miles N on County Road 105.

Rules: Current NRA Smallbore (22 Rimfire) Rules 2.2 (3.3&3.12)
a. Rifle weight 8.5 lbs max with sights
b. Any sights
c. Cloth jackets only with elbow pads, no tightening straps, elbow pads OK for prone.
d. Trigger pull not less than 2 lbs
e. Slings may be used in Kneeling and Prone positions only.
NOTE: Rifles will be weighed and checked!!!

Distance & Targets: Fifty (50) feet using official A32 six bull NRA targets with backers.

Course of Fire: This is a three position match consisting of:
Match #1 - 20 Shots Prone Match #2 - 20 Shots Kneeling
Match #3 - 20 shoots Standing Match #4 - Aggregate of all 3 for State Champion

Eligibility: Open to those who are SD Shooting Sports members..Bring your membership Card!
\$10 Annual and \$100 Life Memberships are available the day of the shoot.
